Spanish

What resources should I use?	You can find all the vocabulary and grammar in the booklet that you have, called <i>Spanish Vocabulary: Whole List</i> , and on this link: tinyurl.com/Spanish2023Year7
What the exam will be like?	Listening: multiple choice and open short answer. Reading: multiple choice and open short answer. Writing: photo description, and open short and long answers. Translation from Spanish to English: short text. Translation from English to Spanish: short sentences.
